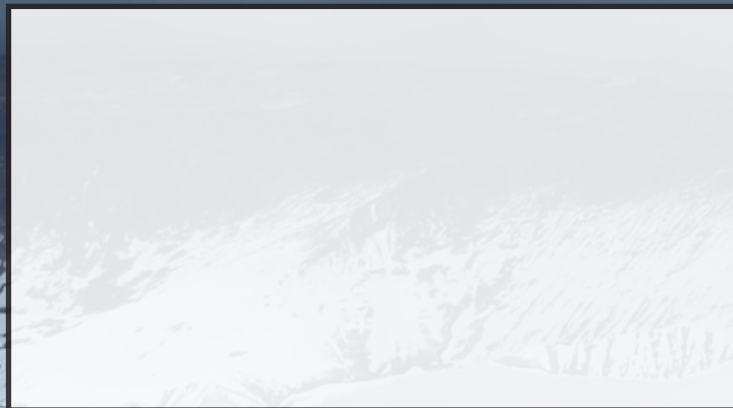

### 2013 Kodiak bear hunting news & 2014 forecast

I OFTEN MARVEL that we have a treasure like Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge. Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge encompasses 80% of Kodiak Island itself, and the Refuge's principal goal is the management of its great bears. Highly regulated hunting is an integral part of keeping the bears wild and keeping a healthy balance. Several reality TV shows are being shot on Kodiak and will show up on your TV in the coming months. I welcome factual documentaries, but I don't know how "real" the reality shows will be. One show will be titled, something like, "Kodiak Bear Guides". The producers have reserved the right to show anything or anyone in a good or bad light, or even to resell the footage to another company with unknown agendas. I decided not to participate.

Kodiak bear populations remain at historically high levels on Kodiak Island due to the habitat protection of Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge and the conservative management of the bears by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game.

Every hunt is truly a different fair chase adventure. I only conduct hunts that I think will be successful, and I look forward to taking you on a hunt.
