

### 2012 Kodiak bear hunting news & 2013 forecast

I am especially proud that 100% of the bears we took were males. I and my staff very carefully try to determine if a bear is male before stalking it. There are several reasons for this, including that males average about a foot bigger than females.

The conservative management by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game and Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge has led to many years of increasing population and especially an increasing population of old big bears. Weather before and during a hunt has a effect on how many bears are sighted. I do everything possible to mitigate this, including voluntarily rescheduling a hunt if conditions look poor.

I strongly respect the time and money that is invested by a hunter, and only conduct hunts that I am confident that the hunter has a good chance to take a good bear. Feel free to call or e-mail me.
